Get silly and use your creativity to add your own unique touch to famous artwork from the past! Ages 6-11.



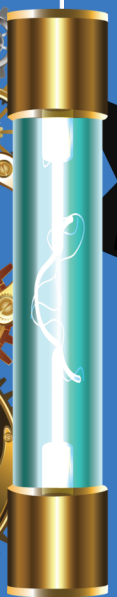
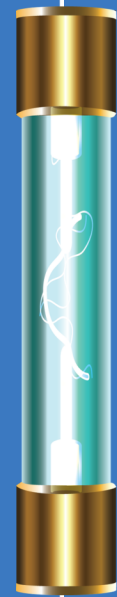

Enjoy some spooky tales from around the world as we discuss the origins of Urban Legends.

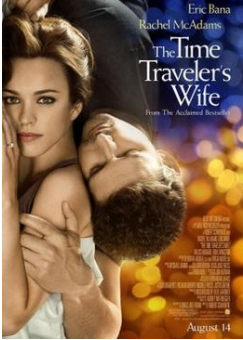
