Join us to learn about the history of Cave Art and make our own creative design!



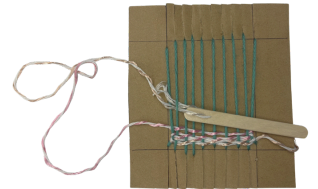
PROGRAMS FOR TEENS (GRADES 6-12)

POE-etry Critique Group - Wednesday, June 10 at 1 p.m.

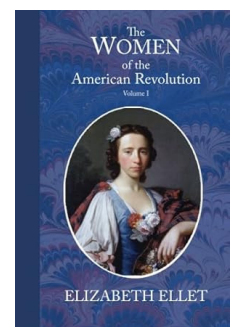
Gather with fellow poets to share and improve your work. Bring six copies of one or two poems to share (limited to 3 pages). Come early if you need us to make copies for you.
