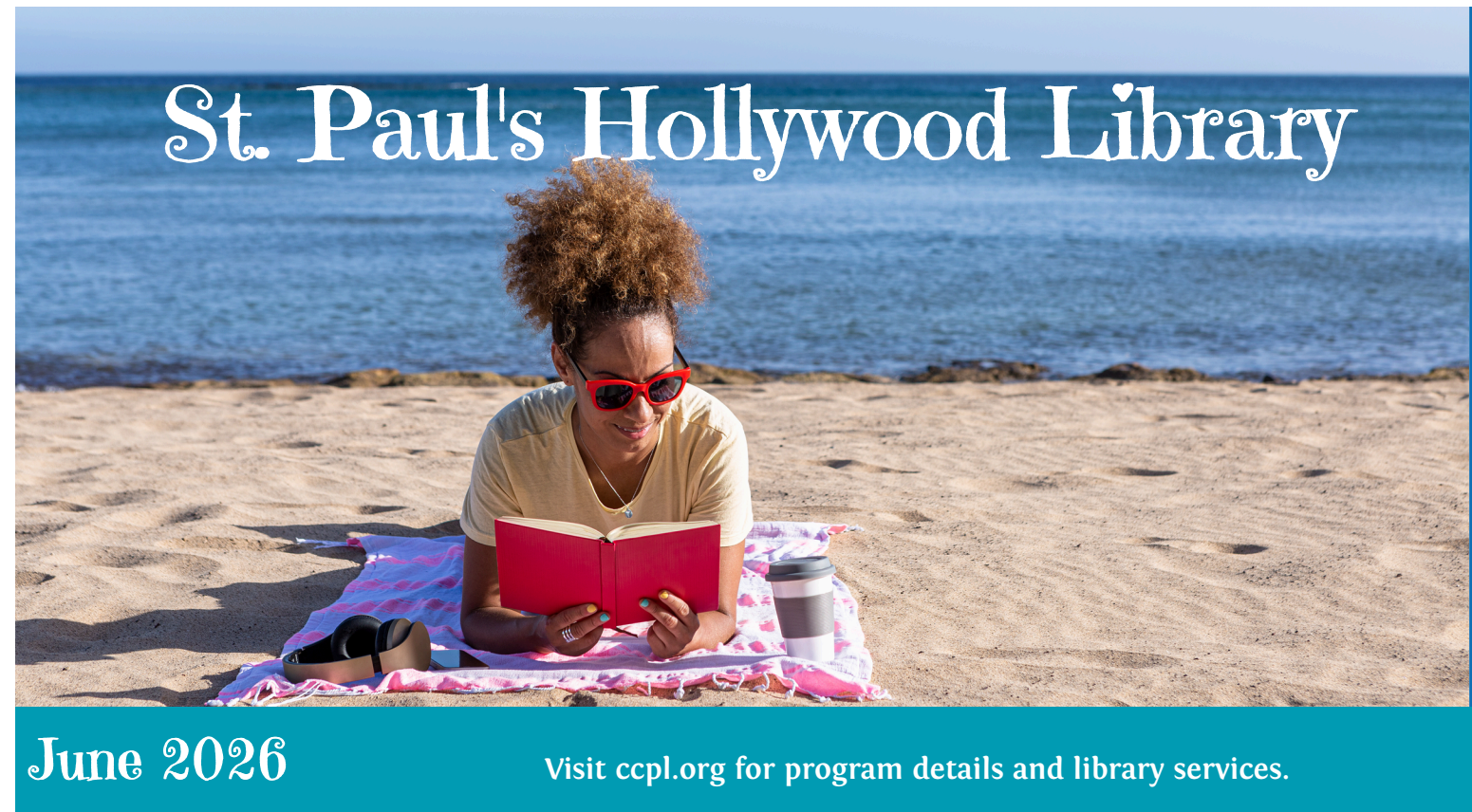

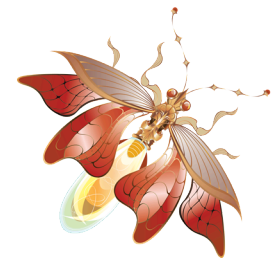
**The Quest for Liberty: An Art Exhibition and Live Demonstration**
