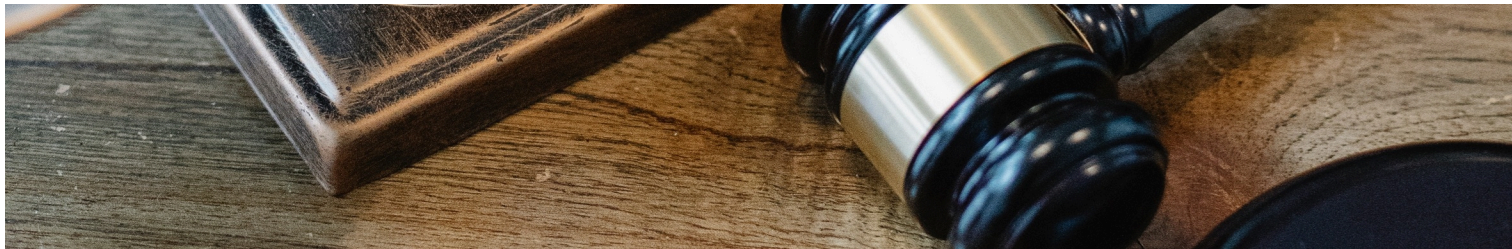


Baby Storytime (ages 0-2)
