Want to learn more about Cricut? Come learn the basics of Cricut and what you need to get started! Also includes a live demonstration of how to put vinyl on a cup.



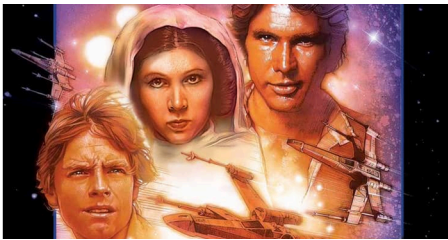
### Piccolo Spoleto: Artist Workshops
