


## Featured Programs



### "From White Sand to Red Clay" author talk and booksigning

**Saturday, May 4 at 11:30 a.m.**

Robert Bailey transports us to a different time on Sullivan's Island through the eyes of his mother. Mary Margaret Knight was born in Charleston in 1921 and experienced a tumultuous childhood including five years at the Charleston Catholic Asylum before she and her sister Nora were reunited with their parents, and they moved to Sullivan's Island. Mary Margaret met John Billy Bailey at a dance on Labor Day weekend in 1938, and they married after a five-day courtship. After a brief visit to Georgia, they returned to Sullivan's Island where they raised their family from 1938 to 1952. Told in the voice of his resilient mother, Robert Bailey paints a vivid, complicated, unsentimental picture of life in Charleston and East of the Cooper from the 1920s to the 1950s.

**12-2 p.m.** - beginners (all levels welcome but must be willing to answer questions and coach)


**4-6 p.m.** - experienced players


